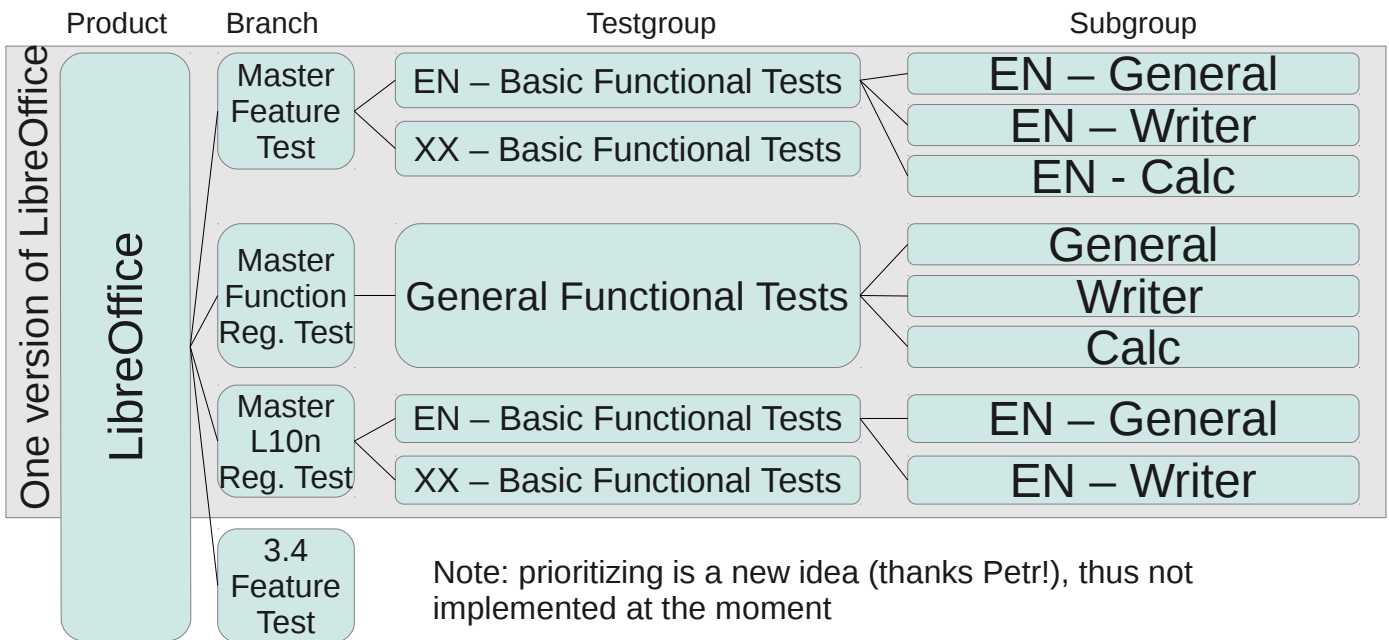


TCM reorganization proposal

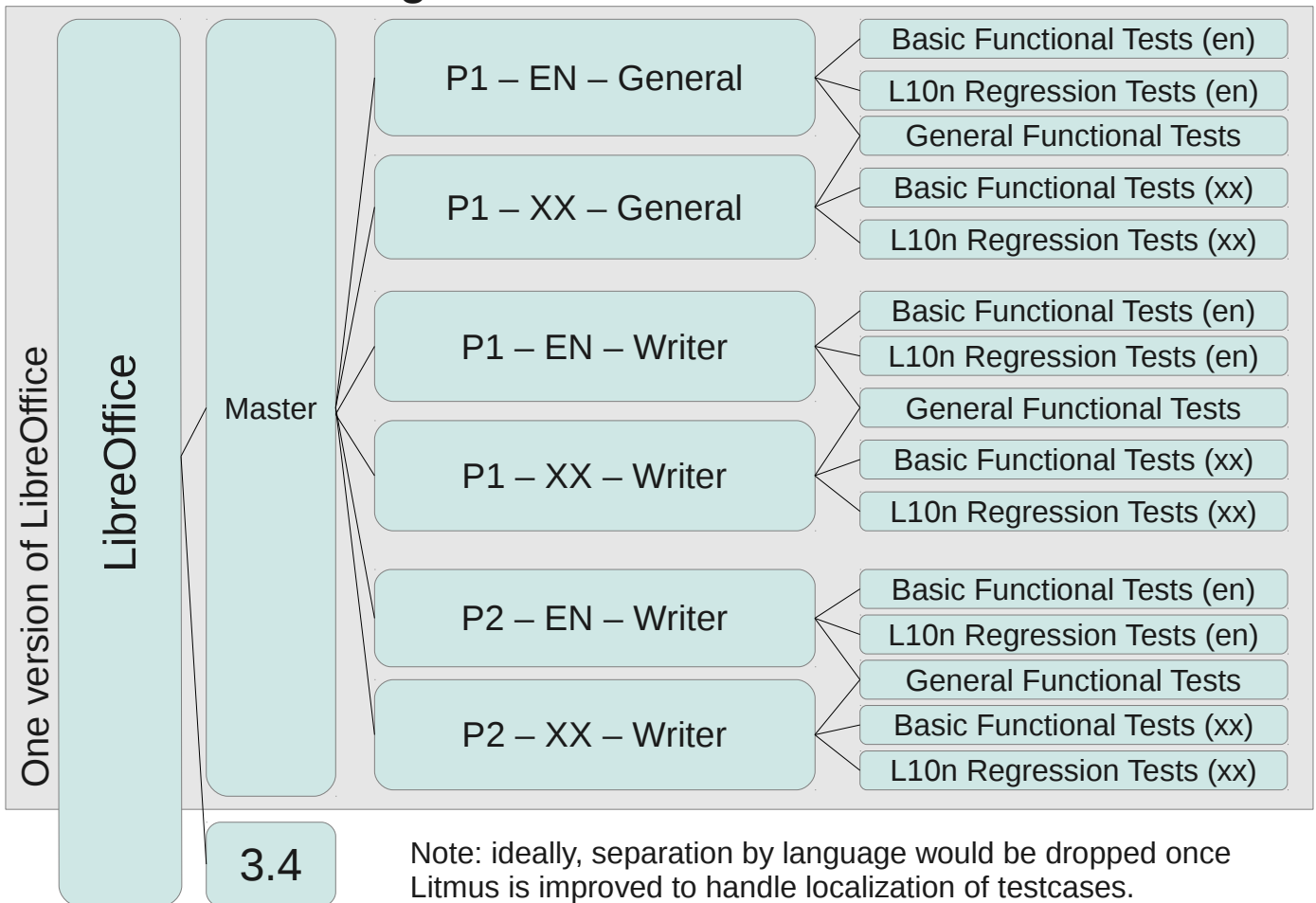
Assumption: A testrun can comprise of one or more testgroups within a single product/branch. Individual subgroups cannot be chosen. That is a Litmus limitation.

What we have now



A single testrun covering all aspects of a single LibO version cannot be created. When running a test, the user chooses just one testgroup (=locale) and one or more subgroups.

What I think might be nice



Separate test runs can be created for each priority, locale, LibO component or any combination of these. The ability to differentiate by the type of test (last column) is lost though. Note that the General Functional Tests (with the same Priority) subgroup and its contents is shared between multiple locales. When running a catch-all test, the user would choose one or more testgroups/subgroups.
